** IMPORTANT NOTICE **

HURRICANE DORIAN – TEMPORARY FUNDING SUSPENSION

The National Weather Service indicates that Hurricane Dorian is now a category 1 hurricane and tracking up the Eastern Coastline – Florida, Georgia, and South Carolina. Hurricane Dorian is expected to bring tropical storm force winds including inland flooding, rainfall, storm-surges, hazardous seas, and the potential for isolated tornadic activity for some coastal areas.

Impacted Counties

Effective with this announcement, Towne Mortgage is temporarily suspending loan purchase activities as follows:

- Florida (26 counties)
- Georgia (12 counties)
- South Carolina (8 counties)

(See the affected counties listed below)

Counties included in the temporary funding suspension are indicated by National Hurricane Center maps as potentially sustaining substantial damage as Hurricane Dorian makes landfall, and in the days following. Many of these counties are currently under mandatory evacuation orders.
